SPEED AND ROAD SIGNS

Following the results of the survey undertaken in 2005/2006 asking residents what they felt about speed signs the committee will be implementing the recommendations put forward by the majority of respondents which was the process agreed at last years AGM. It is therefore planned to have a Private Road / No Through Road sign as part of the Rowly Drive road name sign and a 20mph speed sign.

We would also like to once again remind everyone to take care as they drive along the road and to avoid parking on the verge as this restricts the line of sight and can prove dangerous.

VOLUNTARY BONFIRE CODE

As it's the time of year where residents are wanting to burn the excess foliage from the garden, please could we remind you of the voluntary 'bonfire code' for the drive put forward at the AGM 2005. This means using 'common sense' and being courteous to all neighbours - not just those living next door! The ideas were: not in the day time if possible when washing is out (it is realised that some people have gardeners and so it is inevitable), not on a hot day or evening when we're all out enjoying the rare weather and our windows are open, burn dry matter not wet, try to burn at dusk when the weather is still and hot dry fires go up not all around, take rubbish to the dump esp. noxious materials due to their smells.
